1. Objectives

- Practice oral communication skills in a team environment.
- Self critique on your presentation

2. Specific Details

In class, you gave a presentation about the requirements for your medicine monitoring system. Overall, you discussed many aspects of this project. While the elicitation activities are very important, so are the communication skills you practiced by giving the presentation to the class. While humbling, we often learn best by being forced to watch ourselves make mistakes. But then again, a mistake only matters if one allows it to be made a second time. Each presenter will be responsible for watching their presentation online and submitting via e-mail a one paragraph critique of the presentation. In specific, the critique should address:

1. What was your biggest mistake in the presentation?
2. What part of the presentation do you feel was most effective and / or the best part of the presentation?
3. Were there items in your delivery that distracted from the presentation (i.e. notes reading, excess motion, facing the screen too much, etc.)?
4. How effective was the team at transitioning topics and speakers (aka how was the flow of the presentation)
